The international fellowship program of the Bayer Science & Education Foundation supports extraordinarily gifted talents in order to help them realize individual study and research projects abroad.

Scholarships are granted exclusively to students from German-speaking countries wishing to study abroad, or to foreign students who are interested in a study project in Germany.

Scholarships for individual applications:

- **Otto Bayer Scholarship:** natural sciences (Biology, molecular biology, biochemistry);
- **Carl Duisberg Scholarship:** medicine (Human medicine, Veterinary medicine, Medical sciences, medical engineering, public health);
- **Jeff Schell Scholarship:** agro sciences
- **Kurt Hansen Scholarship:** science teachers
- **Hermann Strenger Scholarship:** apprentices

The current application period for Otto Bayer, Carl Duisberg, Jeff Schell, Kurt Hansen and Hermann Strenger Scholarships is from June 1, 2014 to July 15, 2014.

The independent Foundation Board will hold its selection meeting on September 5, 2014.
